Terminal Handling Destination (DHC) – World to South Africa Cluster

Dear Customer

We wish to remind you of the advisory we issued in line with the Transnet increase, specifically relating to the increase in DHC charges applicable 1st April 2020. For exports we can effectively price the OHC that is applicable 1st April 2020. For imports, our pricing was determined at the time of export activity gate in at origin and thus priced against the DHC at that time. For any container discharged on or post 1st April 2020 we must recover the increase in DHC in the following way:

Our usual invoices reflect:

Terminal Handling Service – Destination: with the container quantity and the rate.

In the interim period, invoices will have an additional line item reflecting as **Additional Import Service Fee** with the difference updated.

You may reference the below table for the difference in costs which we will recover.
